For the second year in a row, TWR MOTION assisted the Media to Movements training coalition in equipping field teams. Five teams gathered October 17-19 at Pioneers headquarters in Orlando to learn and encourage each other. Rachel guided the teams through creating social media ads and filming testimonies on a phone. Andrew shared creative problem solving on videos with limited resources. Each session was practical with hands-on application of new skills. Everyone built a video, posted it on social media and tracked responses to the good news about Jesus.
